#### Corelli

Concerto No 8 in G minor 3<sup>rd</sup> + 4<sup>th</sup> mvts: Vivace + Allegro

#### Schubert

Symphony No 5 in B flat. 1<sup>st</sup> mvt: Allegro

#### Chopin

Nocturne Op 9 No 2 - Andante
